A MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear Friends in Christ,

This weekend the Church celebrates the Solemnity of Corpus Christi - which we now call in English *The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ*. On this day we remember two things. The first is that Jesus left us his own Body and Blood in the Eucharist as a memorial sacrifice which we will have until he comes again in glory. The second aspect of this feast is that all of us - no matter who we are and no matter what our ethnic identities - form the Body of Christ. When we imitate the Lord in the way we live, that Body is strengthened. When we stray from that, the Body of Christ becomes weaker. This weekend renew your relationship with the Lord and determine that whatever you do will build Christ's Body here on earth.

We list today the members of the Class of 2017 who graduated last Tuesday from St. Christopher School. Many of them achieved awards. At the same time, I told them that just graduating from our school was the most important award they needed. I want to pay special recognition to one of our graduates Emily Covolesky.
